The U.S. Department of State's Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship enables students to study or intern abroad, providing them with critical skills to succeed in the 21st century workforce. The Gilman Program aims to diversify the kinds of students who study and intern abroad and the countries and regions where they go by providing grants of up to \$5,000 to U.S. undergraduate students of limited financial means to participate in credit-bearing study abroad or international internship programs.

Students applying for any academic term must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Citizen of the United States
- Undergraduate student in good academic standing
- Federal Pell Grant recipient
- Student in the process of applying to, or accepted for, a study abroad or internship program
- Student applying for a program in an eligible country, according to U.S. Department of State guidance

Contact the Financial Aid and Study Abroad advisors at your home college / university to notify them that you are applying for the Gilman Scholarship. In order to complete the application online, applicants need advisor certifications and transcripts.


Note that, although it is possible to find internship opportunities outside of OSU GO, the education/internship abroad programs listed on OSU GO's website are the only programs that OSU has approved. This university approval allow students participating in these programs to both earn OSU resident credits and finance the program by accessing their OSU financial aid. While some programs may originate from OSU and others are offered by distinct program providers, all programs appearing on the OSU GO website qualify as fully supported by OSU.

International Internships through IE3 Global

If you have relevant experience in your field and are seeking to contribute your skills and knowledge to an international host organization, you can do an international internship through OSU's IE3 Global program. IE3 Global provides high-quality study abroad, internship, research, exchange, and faculty-led programs to the students of OSU. Internships are best suited for students interested in an independent and immersive experience abroad.

Research Abroad

It is also possible to research abroad. Research focused internships are available through IE3 Global, or you may find that your needs are best met by individualized directed study. This can take the form of specific individualized study overseas or, more often, a research project.
